

Statement on California Proposition 65

To Whom It May Concern:

The California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, commonly known as California Proposition 65 or 'Prop 65', requires businesses to inform Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that the state of California has determined to present a risk of cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.
